


## Student Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)

Multi-factor authentication (MFA) is a multi-step account sign in process that requires users to enter more information than just a password. For increased security for your data, Edmark Online now requires MFA upon sign in for Teachers and School Admins.


- 1. For Teachers and School
  Admins: An email will be sent
  to the teacher with a 7-digit
  authentication code to enter on
  the sign in screen.
- 2. For Students: MFA for students is optional, with the choice to enable or disable MFA for individual and groups of students. MFA for Students is intended to be quick and easy for both Teachers and Students.
- **3.** When the Student signs in, an email will be sent to their teacher of record with a link to click.
- 4. In some cases, having the student access and enter an authentication code may not be practical—for example, when students are working remotely or have difficulty managing signing in. Since student's access to the program presents extremely low, if any, risk of others seeing data, Teachers can easily elect to disable the MFA for individual or all students.
- 5. To disable MFA for an individual student: unselect the MFA box by the Student's name on the Teacher Home Page or on the student's profile.
- **6.** School Admins may disable MFA for all students: select the Student MFA button on the Home Page, choose Disabled and choose Apply to all students in the school right now.
